DECLARING OCTOBER 19, 2006 AS
CONFLICT RESOLUTION DAY

WHEREAS, mediation empowers individuals to develop solutions to conflicts that strengthen relationships and are tailored to their particular needs; and

WHEREAS, students throughout Florida are learning the skills of mediation and assisting their peers in resolving conflicts peacefully;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 3rd day of October, 2006, that October 19, 2006, in Palm Beach County, is hereby declared:
